# Introduction Spanish Language and Culture for Teachers

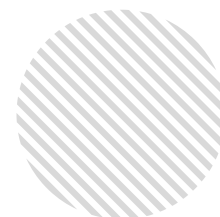

## *Course Objectives: Spanish Language and Culture for Teachers*

- To build vocabulary and expressions related to education, school life, student support, and intercultural exchange, tailored to the needs of teachers and school staff.
- To increase participants' confidence and fluency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing in Spanish through practical, immersive, and interactive learning methods.
- To explore Spanish culture and traditions, fostering a deeper understanding of the local context and promoting cultural awareness and sensitivity in diverse classrooms.
- To support professional and personal development by encouraging the use of Spanish in cross-border cooperation, Erasmus+ partnerships, and international networking.
- To create a personal language learning plan, including digital tools and strategies to continue developing Spanish skills beyond the course.

# ***Action Training Spanish Language and Culture for Teachers***

## ***Day 1***

### ***Welcome & Introduction to – Welcome & Getting Started with Spanish***

- Welcome and introduction to the training program
- Presentation of the timetable and course information
- Ice-breaker and participant introductions in Spanish
- Basic greetings, introductions, and classroom vocabulary
- Interactive activities to practice pronunciation and listening

## ***Day 2***

### ***Everyday Communication in Spanish***

- Ordering food, asking for directions, using transport
- Spanish numbers, time, and common phrases
- Role-playing everyday situations (at the café, supermarket, pharmacy)
- Introduction to basic Spanish grammar (present tense, regular verbs)
- Cultural session: Spanish customs and daily life

## ***Day 3***

### ***Spanish in the School Environment***

- Vocabulary and expressions for school and classroom situations
- Communicating with students and colleagues in Spanish
- Understanding timetables, school supplies, and classroom instructions
- Overview of the Spanish education system (levels, curriculum, schedules)
- School visit or virtual tour (optional based on location)

## ***Day 4***

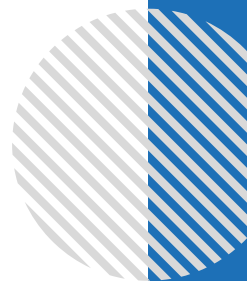
### ***Grammar & Cultural Immersion***

- Grammar focus: irregular verbs, articles, and prepositions
- Expressing opinions and asking questions in Spanish
- Outdoor or experiential activity: cultural visit, museum, or local site
- Cultural workshop: Spanish festivals, music, or cuisine
- Reflection session: language progress and cultural insights

## ***Day 5***

### ***Practice, Evaluation & Certification***

- Speaking practice: mini dialogues and real-life simulations
- Group activity: preparing a short presentation in Spanish
- Personal language learning plan: how to keep improving
- Course feedback and reflection
- Certification ceremony & group photo
